A SUMMER TO GROW ON

AGES 3-6

(NOT ENTERING FIRST GRADE)

Our 9AM-1PM program located in the All Day Montessori Children's House is open to all potty-trained children from the ages of 3 to 6 years. The content and specific activities are based on the interest of the individual child and follow Montessori theory in regards to the child's developmental needs. Families needing care until 3PM have the option in this room where naps will be included. If further care is required, our Extended Care program is available until 6PM. There will be no afternoon Extended Care on July 30 the last day of the program.

A typical day includes stories, songs, movement and rhythmic activities, cooking, art and sharing lunch together. *(Please remember that promptness is essential to the smooth operation of a summer program day. Thank you for your cooperation.)*

- The children are free to choose outdoor activities including gardening and the adjacent playground.
- We go on weekly "nature walks" around nearby Shaker Lakes.
- Occasional guest presentations and performances include visits from the zoo and concerts given by local musicians.
- There is a wading pool available when weather permits.

APPAREL

Each child should bring an extra change of clothing and a pair of indoor shoes. No flip-flops, please. A bathing suit and towel may be kept at camp or brought on pool day. Dress the child in casual wear that may get dirty or become stained and in shoes that are secure on his/her feet.

LUNCH

The program supplies a morning snack. The children bring their own lunch. We have flatware, napkins and cup so none of that needs to be packed. We will have a potluck picnic on Thursday July 29. Parents and other family members are invited to join the campers.

All parents must complete the full registration and medical forms, including extended care options.
